Happy New Year everyone, and I hope you had a very Merry Christmas. As the New Year begins, we have some challenges ahead of us. The post has continuously lost money over the last few years and we need to come up with a way to stop this. We sent out surveys a couple years ago asking for input on ways to slow the losses. We had many very good suggestions that we tried, but none seemed to help. We started an American Legion Post to help bring in new people and that has helped. The Legion is still growing so we are seeing some new people in the post, which is good. We need to bring in about \$320 a day to break even. This time of year we have no problem, but in the summer months we just do not have enough business to break even. We have a beautiful post home, but it costs money to operate, electric utilities alone are normally well over \$1000 a month. Starting in January we are going to reevaluate our drink prices so do not be surprised of you see some price increases. We try to keep our prices as low as possible, but sometimes we just need to face the situation and raise them. On a brighter note, we have a calendar FULL of events for January. LOOK at our calendar and please come out and join us for an event and support your post. In addition, we are still trying to make All State this year, but we need people to renew their memberships. If you have not renewed yet please take the time to do it now. Last year we changed from ADT security to Westco, saving the post over \$2200 a year but the down side of that decision is that the key card system is propriety to ADT. We can no longer buy key cards. We are almost out, so if you do not have a key card you will just need to ring the bell and show your membership card to get in. A new key card system is expensive so for the time being we are just going to make do with our existing system. Please have patience, too, when standing at the door. 
When Don returned home from Vietnam, he brought horrific memories from the war back with him. To make matters more difficult, some of his peers looked down on his service. Don busied himself at home to avoid situations that might evoke feelings that he wanted to bury. After 9/11, many bad memories came flooding back, and his behavior and quality of life started to change. Don decided to seek assistance, but had never talked to a mental health professional before and wasn't sure what to expect. His U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) doctor provided him with concrete steps to manage his symptoms and start the healing process. Each visit to his psychiatrist helped Don feel better, and his wife noticed improvement right away. Now Don tells his story hoping it will encourage other veterans to reach out for support.

The Make the Connection campaign features stories of resilience and recovery like Don's - from veterans of every age, experience, and service era. The Make the Connection website (MakeTheConnection.net), is a one-stop resource where veterans and their families and friends can privately explore topics including health, wellness, and common challenges.

<u>MakeTheConnection.net</u> features hundreds of videos of veterans talking openly about their personal experiences with mental health treatment, recovery, and paths to leading healthier, happier lives. These real stories encourage other veterans to seek help and take the first step toward recovery.
