Greetings, this year seems to be flying. We are currently getting ramped up for Thunder Beach. We are selling adult beverages at Harley Davidson for 9 days, April 23rd thru May 1st. We are also doing breakfast at the post Thursday, Friday and Saturday the same week. We need help. If you can help us selling beer or with breakfast please let me know. I'm coordinating the volunteers for all the organizations that call our post home.

Sunday April 17th the post will be closed for spring cleaning. We do this twice a year, spring and fall, to get the deep cleaning that isn't done during daily clean-up. The post will provide pizza for lunch to those that are helping with the cleaning. We will have a list of things we want done. These tasks will range from heavy to light, so we can use any help we can get.

Billie has retired as Post Manager. I want to thank her for the tremendous job she has done these past years. This is a very involved job that happens behind the scenes so most people don't understand what it involved. Basically the post manager runs the \$200,000 a year business. Running the post is a business. We like to think of it as a club, but the Canteen and kitchen are what pays the bills. In the summer months the electric bill runs over \$1500 a month, then add phone, cable, gas, wages, etc. and our expenses are high. Also the summer months are the slowest at the canteen so our revenue is down. We need help to keep our post open. How can you help? Participate in the functions at the post. Buy a brick for the Wall, we still have them half price this month, so get them while they are reduced. Jack and I are assuming the post manager job for a while on a voluntary basis to help reduce costs during the summer months. We are both new to this so have some patience with us please.
