I spent literally hours building a new post roster that now resides on a PC that belongs to the post and that will be in the custody of the present and future Adjutant. Comrade Quartermaster Rob Smith is going to supply me with updates when members join or transfer out but the data I have is incomplete. This means that anytime anyone needs any admin support, for instance when our Comrade SVC Tracey Lopez was asked to send letters out to all annual members reminding them to pay dues soonest to avoid the increase 1 January, someone is going to be overlooked due to inconsistent data. To fix that the Adjutant is going to now be the "Go to Guy/Gal" for POC information for Comrades' phone numbers, E-mails or addresses.

And now, for the bottom line. The POC information for all 329 VFW membership records I maintain stinks, stinks, stinks. The source of our data is the National VFW HQ. That database itself has many undeliverable addresses and fewer than 50% have phone numbers. This is because we as members of this upstanding Veterans Service Organization have not provided or updated our information to National. How is the Post Service Officer going to be able to call you and help you with your VA claim if he or she cannot call you? How can the Post Surgeon call your significant other and ask if there is anything the post can do to help our comrade in the hospital if no phone number is on file? How can the Post Commander call and congratulate you on some award or happy news if he or she has no phone number? They cannot at this time. Information must flow, and as Adjutant I am the Chief Information Officer.

I am requesting that every comrade spend 5 minutes on the phone with me (850-703-7636) to check what I have on file (I will carry a hard copy with me) OR follow these instructions to go online to VFW National and set up an online account. Once you do this you can change your address, pay annual dues online, upgrade to Life Member online, find your membership benefits (PLEASE use them), you can even do this as a member of the Men's Auxiliary.

Here goes: First, go here: <u>LOGIN</u> (or <u>https://vfw.org/Login.aspx</u>). Second, select "<u>Create an account</u>" or https://vfw.org/oms/CreateAccount.aspx


