Men's Auxiliary Memo - Bill McGrath, President

Last month I mentioned the national vote against the recognition of the Men's Auxiliaries. That is, the refusal of the VFW to provide to the Men the same recognition currently enjoyed by our Ladies Auxiliaries. Currently, we are a VFW organization that reports to the local Post and only the local Post. Nevertheless, we must follow national directives on membership, procedures and basically all the processes the Ladies Auxiliaries also follow with few exceptions. While the ladies sit side by side with the VFW members at district and state meetings and events, the new are excluded. There is something inherently wrong and unfair when a national organization turns its back on one gender based organization over another. That got your attention, didn't it!! I am not criticizing our wonderful Ladies Auxiliaries and certainly not our state VFW - both have always supported and encouraged our many endeavors. I am, however, criticizing the VFW national leadership for its poor leadership and lack of vision in the affairs of the support organizations. So what can be done? As I mentioned, the Men's Auxiliaries decided to set up a committee to investigate options if the recognition rule change failed. I'm sure the options will go from minimal to "nuclear". That is, at one end we may refuse to provide national any money out of our dues while at the other end, we could seek legal ad-

vice. I find neither of these appealing because both are revolutionary in nature from the modest to the extreme. I would choose an option given to me by a district commander: Florida should go it alone and set up Men's Auxiliary districts. This, I believe, could be done by a state addendum amplifying national rules, whereby the Men's Auxiliary districts are recognized until such times as national provides the required guidelines to correct the gender disparity. We just need a Post to champion the idea. Hey, Post 10555?? Enough said.

On the lighter side, the fish fries continue to be a great success. Last time we added chicken to the menu for a little diversity. If you haven't been to one of these fish fries, you need to try it out. But get your tickets early, since they sell out quickly. Also, if you liked Oktoberfest, we're working on something similar, but with an "island" theme. We hope to have a steel band, a keg of beer, and maybe some island punch and food.
