As I write this month's newsletter article, I'm sitting in a hotel room in Seal Beach, CA, having missed my first meeting as Commander. We recently attended the Department of Florida State Convention. Our National Commander, John Hamilton, attended the conference. He is going to bring before the National Convention to raise the National dues by \$10.00. Our Post's VFW dues are currently \$23.00 a year. Of that \$23.00, \$19.50 goes to National and \$3.50 remains at our post. If the raise is approved at the National Convention, we will have to pay \$29.50 to national when an annual member renews or we get a new member. Obviously we'll need to raise our annual dues, probably to at least \$35.00, but this will need to be approved by the membership before it goes into effect. The raise in national dues will probably be effective 1 January 2014. If you are considering a life membership I highly recommend you purchase it as soon as possible. I believe the price of a life membership is tied to the National Annual dues, so we expect them to go up as well. On a sad note we have had to discontinue the Sunday jam session due to lack of participation. We just can't continue to pay \$180 for entertainment when the total taken at the canteen for the day is only \$235.00. I hope we can resume the jam sessions this fall.
