I hope that each of you members of the VFW; LAVFW; MAVFW; and our American Legion enjoy the benefits of membership in one of the units that share our Post Home at the Beach. When did you first join? My wife Margaret and arrived here two years ago and love it. What reasons did you have to come join this Post? While you reflect on that, who asked you to join the VFW, why did you pick it? My own qualified combat service first brought me to the VFW in 1991 through the insistence of a WWII Veteran who treated me as his equal though I was in the Rear with the Gear in KSA for Desert Storm. That meant the world to me, still does. Our membership, like the rest of the 1.9 Million members like you, gives us the right to participate in the life of the post as a voting member and access to *any* post for any and all activities. I fail to understand why any member would allow that bond, that relationship to lapse and not renew their dues. For the VFW an annual membership costs \$3 a month, paid once a year at \$36. Paid dues open the front door and puts out the Welcome Mat; expired members not invited in as guests are barred from the Post and its activities.

For a moment, consider what belonging to the Triple Nickel means on the social side of the life of the Post in recent weeks and months. We regularly have B-I-N-G-O; Fish Fries; Burger Nights; BBQ Nights; Bike Nights; Pool Tournaments; Pot Lucks, Cards; and Bunco. We have had great Picnics on Memorial Day; Independence Day; Labor Day. We had a HUGE Steak Night hosting the entire Department of Florida VFW. We have a strong Volunteer connection with guests that return to share in the life of our post every year and give in return. Oh, sure, we had a bad time last New Year's Eve with a great band (NOTE: next New Year's Eve will be better) and we have "lost money" on a few events but it's not about the money and it's worth every bit of often unappreciated labor that goes into each event. It is about our family and friends and brother/sister Veterans. It is about having a place to meet and greet one another knowing that each of us has a unique connection to each other, the military service we or someone else we are related to gave to this nation. We have a bond that is as unique as it is, well, special.

We support the Warrior Beach Retreat; Arnold High School's JROTC program. We help Comrades in need regularly... We are INVOLVED in the PCB community and the military community and we make a difference.

Yes, we can do more and we will do more but only if you cast your vote for your continued support of the VFW Post you chose to join. 


