This act prohibits smoking in most business. Fraternal club houses are exempt provided that all work performed is done by members of the membership association. In our case, the VFW is the employer so all employees must be members of the VFW or VFW Auxiliary, which they currently are not. The new state inspection criteria this year require us to list all employees and their membership number. We are currently looking into the act to get more details but this will be discussed at our next house committee meeting and at the general membership meeting.
